Officials are paid the following game fees, plus applicable travel fees. Effective January 1, 2025.

High School teams are advised to budget for three Officials per Varsity game and two Officials for JV or Sixes games. Youth teams are advised to budget for two Officials per game.

Every attempt will be made to ensure a higher number of Officials are available for the respective game. However, if a single Official working a game must occur, a 50% increase in game fees occurs per game, based on the two-person fee.

A “fifth-quarter” is available as an option for developing players if negotiated with the Officials prior to arrival. The fee for a fifth quarter will be added onto the game for a total of 1.25x the original game fee (additional cost will incur if only one Official is available to work the game).

Note: Assigning Fees for 2025 will increase in price from 2024 and will be addressed below with another expected market evaluation in 2026.

Mileage is based off approximate city-to-city center per Google Maps, rounded to nearest fifth mile. Officials who work in one city but live in another will have mileage calculated off their home city. Mileage is only paid to Officials whose primary purpose is to work games. HS coaches or players who travel for their personal games and work youth games will only be compensated the game fee.

Assigners' Fees

High School - ½ a game fee per High School team per season. If programs have multiple teams, such as Varsity and JV, they will be charged for each team needing assignments. Ex. Program A has games at the High School and JV level, they will be charged half a game fee for each level for assigning for the season regardless of the number of games (\$37.50 + \$27.50 = \$65.00).

Youth - \$25.00 for Youth games per age group, per program per season. If a program has one U10 and one U12 team each, it will be charged two fees for assigning (\$50.00), but if a program has one U12 team and two U14 teams, it will only be charged per age group (U12 and U14 for \$50.00).

Programs with boys and girls teams will be charged separately.
